



Driving Directions from Kingscote Airport to LifeTime Private Retreats

Turn left out of the airport for about 1km until you reach a T junction. Turn left at the T junction and then immediately right, following the signs to Parndana (this should be the Playford Highway). You will travel approximately 25 km to Parndana.

1. Travel past Parndana and continue for approximately 4kms before turning right on to the Stokes Bay Road.
2. Continue along Stokes Bay Road. After approximately 10km turn left at Pratt's Rd and the sign to Lifetime Private Retreats. Continue along until you reach a T junction, which is the North Coast Road.
3. Turn left, reaching LifeTime Private Retreats at Snelling Beach, after approximately 7 km.
4. Each house is individually sign posted.
5. FINDING YOUR ACCOMMODATION (No need to check in)
 - a. Pass the LifeTime wall on the left (don't go this way)
 - b. 500 meters from the wall you will see the **SETTLERS HOMESTEAD** on the left (take the right driveway)
 - c. 300 meters past the Settlers Homestead you will see the **SHEOAKS** drive on the left (just before the top of the rise.)
 - d. 150-200 meters from Sheoak's you will then see the **CLIFF HOUSE** on the right (on top of the rise – take the right hand driveway)
 - e. If you continue climbing the next very steep hill all the way to the top you will see the **SKY HOUSE** sign and entrance on the right.

Should you have any difficulties you should have mobile coverage on this hill and you will be able to call the office on 8559 2248 or 8559 2236.

Alternately, follow the map on the fold-out first page of the Kangaroo Island Visitor & Information Guide to Snelling's Beach.

The trip will take around 90 minutes. If you have any problems please call the LifeTime office on the Island on 08-8559 2248 but be aware that mobile phones receive very little coverage on the Island.

IMPORTANT DRIVING & SAFETY: Please be careful when driving on Kangaroo Island as the roads can get quite slippery. Take corners very slowly, and we recommend you don't drive at dawn and dusk because of the native wildlife that often stray onto the roads. Just take your time and enjoy the island pace!
